CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

Eligibility: Entrants must be male members in good standing of an RGA member club on the day of the tournament or have paid the \$25 RGA annual fee.

Format: The format of this competition will be 18 holes of four-ball stroke play, as outlined in Rule 31 of the Rules of Golf. The champion shall be the team returning the lowest gross score for 18 holes of stroke play. There will be two divisions, Senior (aged 50 – 64 years) and Legends (aged 65+). Both competitors must be eligible to play in the respective divisions.

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$150. Entry fee includes cart fee, range balls and all prizes.

Entries: All checks should be made payable to the RGA and the entry form should be mailed to Steve Serrao, 7741 Pocoshock Way, Richmond, VA 23235. Phone number is 804.640.5350. Entrants may also pay on-line at www.richmondgolf.net

Code of conduct: Entries are subject to rejection at any time (including during the event by the committee) for reasons such as conduct unbecoming or actions that are detrimental to other players. Players will be subject to suspension or probation for such actions.

Deadline: Entry forms must be received no later than April 14, 2017. Entrants will receive confirmation of acceptance by email. No refund of entry fee will be allowed after April 14, 2017.

Ties: If there is a tie for the overall champion, the tie will be decided by a hole-by-hole playoff beginning at the hole specified by the tournament committee. The playoff will begin 5 minutes after the completion of play. All other ties will be decided by a match of cards. The winner when matching cards will first be determined by the best score for holes 10-18, second on the basis of holes 13-18, third on the basis of holes 16-18, fourth on the basis of the 18th hole, fifth on the basis of the first handicap hole, sixth on the basis of the second handicap hole, and so on until a winner is decided.

Prizes: All prizes will be in the form of gift certificates redeemable at the host club. The awards ceremony and reception for all participants will be held immediately following the conclusion of play.

Dress Code: All competitors in this event must adhere to the dress code and other rules and regulations of the host club, and must wear proper golf attire at all times.

Schedule: One practice round is available for all entrants at the discretion of the host club if the entrant's application has been received at the time of the practice round request. The club should be called directly to request and schedule a practice round. The cost of the practice round is determined by the club. The tournament round is scheduled for a 12:00 PM shotgun start. We will have appetizers and refreshments following play, compliments of the RGA.
