CONDITIONS OF THE COMPETITION

Eligibility: Entrant must be a male member in good standing of an RGA member club and must be at least 25 years of age on the first day of the tournament. Participants must have a VSGA handicap index established at an RGA member club and meet the USGA Rules of Amateur status. Players who are not members of an RGA club may participate by paying a \$25 fee in addition to the entry fee.

Format: The format of this competition will be 36 holes of stroke play, as outlined in Rule 3 of the Rules of Golf. The champion shall be the player returning the lowest gross score for 36 holes of stroke play.

Entry Fee: The entry fee is \$150. Entry fee includes cart fees and range balls for both days. It also includes all prizes and a reception for all players on August 5th. Any entry received or requested after the deadline of 5 p.m. July 31st will be subject to a late fee charge of \$25.

Entries: All checks should be made payable to the RGA and the entry form should be mailed to Steve Serrao, 7741 Pocoshock Way, Richmond, VA 23235 or register on line on the RGA website, www.richmondgolf.net.

Deadline: Entry forms must be received no later than July 31st, 2017. Entrants will receive confirmation of acceptance by email for mailed entries. Online entrants will receive an order confirmation. No refunds for entry fee will be allowed after July 27th, 2017.

Time of Starting: If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.

Ties: If there is a tie for the overall champion, the tie will be decided by a hole-by-hole playoff beginning at the hole specified by the tournament committee. The playoff will begin 10 minutes after the completion of play. All other ties will be decided by low 2nd round score. If the 2nd round score is the same, there will then be a match of cards. The winner when matching cards will first be determined by the best score for holes 10-18, second on the basis of holes 13-18, third on the basis of holes 16-18, fourth on the basis of the 18th hole, fifth on the basis of the first handicap hole, sixth on the basis of the second handicap hole, and so on until a winner is decided.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to at least the lowest three scores in each flight based on the total gross score. The total number of flights will depend on the number of entries. With the maximum number of entries, there will be four flights. Players will be put into flights based on their scores for the first day. All prizes will be in the form of gift certificates redeemable at the host club.

Dress Code: All competitors in this event must adhere to the dress code and other rules and regulations of the host club, and must wear proper golf attire at all times.

Schedule: A practice round is available for all entrants if the entrant's application has been received at the time of the practice round request. Call the club directly to request and schedule a practice round. Please identify that it is for the RGA Mid-Amateur. The cost of the practice round is \$25 including cart. The first tournament round is Friday, August 4th, and is scheduled for a 1 p.m. shotgun start. The second tournament round is Saturday, August 5th, and is scheduled for consecutive tee times in the morning.
